

## Bye Laws

September 2022

1. The Committee may from time to time make such bye laws as they may deem necessary or expedient or convenient for the proper conduct and management of the Club and for the purposes of prescribing classes of and conditions of membership and in particular the Committee may by such bye laws regulate:

#### Membership

- A Member shall be defined as one who has paid the annual club subscription, which is due on 30<sup>th</sup> April each year. The Committee may decide to waive, increase, or decrease, the annual club subscription.
- No Member under the age of 16.
- Leigh-on-Sea Striders will close membership at 400 members. This number will be reviewed each year ahead of the Annual General Meeting.
- Members who are 16-17 will be accompanied to training and events by their parent/carer who is an adult member of the club.
